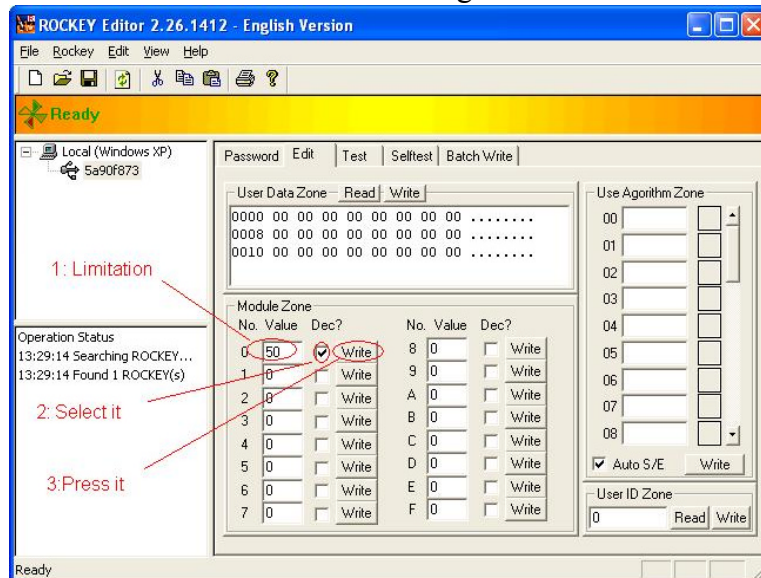


Set Run Time Limitation with ROCKEY Enveloper

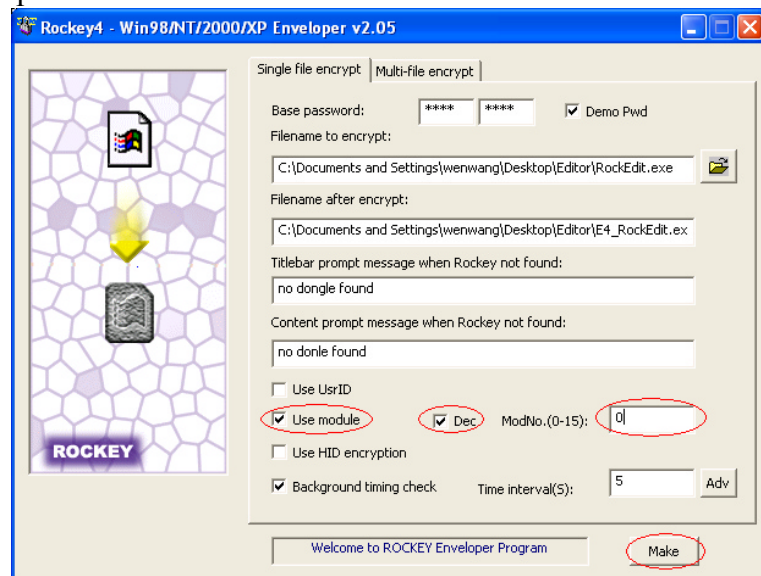
Feitian's ROCKEY software protection dongle provide a function that can set the number of application's run time via enveloper. Such function bring ease to developer so that can limit how many time that the application can run. For example, a software can only run 50 times in demo version, a developer can easily implement this function without any additional program work with the help of enveloper.

1. Open rockedit.exe to set a module zone of the dongle.



You can select a module zone as you want. Here use module 0 as an example. Input the number of limitation, and make sure the 'Dec' option is checked. Press the 'Write' to write the info to the dongle.

2. Run RyEnv32.exe to start the enveloper, input the password and select the application that needs to be protected.



Make sure that “use module” is selected, and select “Dec”. In the module box, input the number of module that you can check. This number should be the same with the module number that edited in rockedit.exe. Finally, press “ make” to finish the enveloping process.
